## Sri Sri Vidya Mandir (Tribal School) Dist. Singhbhum East

We are extremely thankful for your continued support for the Tribal cause. Your regular contribution over the years has helped us in sustaining and expanding our activities.

This year on 15th April we completed 16 years of 'Transformation' with renewed vigour to empower the tribal children to realize their potential and uplift their villages.

## The highlights of the year

- **Digital Class Rooms:** 10 schools have been equipped with sets of Solar panels, Projector and Laptop to use Computer as a learning tool. The remaining 5 will have their solar sets in 2015-16.
- Clean India: Clean Schools'. The Swachh Bharat Abhiyan has been taken in earnestness by students to ensure that all Sri Sri Vidya Mandir schools have well maintained water, sanitation and hygiene facilities. One village was selected by each school to continue the movement till villagers keep the village clean of their own.
- *'Connecting the Hearts of East to the Hearts of West'!* Pune visit of Tribal students from Jharkhand is an annual feature. 19 Student of class VII and IX went to Pune and participated in different cultural activities and impressed the audience at various places with their performance in dance, drama, competition etc.
- A **new** women empowerment cell to train village women to supplement their family earnings has been established.
- Technical Training Centre was formally inaugurated by Tribal Welfare Minister of Jharkhand Government in Sept. 2014. It trained the first batch of students in Electric Wiring (Domestic and Industrial)
- The awareness for planting trees among children helped in planting 2 saplings by each child near his/her house so that these can be maintained by them.
- A new concept **BAL MELA** was introduced where children of 2/3 schools meet and have fun, games, prizes and learning and food for the day. This helped the children of different schools to know each other.
- The present strength of students, with new admission of 600 children, is about 3,600 in 20 Schools.

**YOU** who have helped these first generation learners to attain the height they have reached and now they look forward to future with hope and confidence.
