## Mission Statement

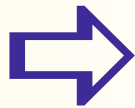
**To ensure transformation of the Indian Tribal through education of the Tribal Child.**

Inspired by His Holiness Sri Sri Ravi Shankar, Founder of the Art of Living Foundation, and moved by his personal encounters with poverty-stricken tribal families in India, Brij Chawla and a small team of volunteers started building schools in the highly remote and inaccessible tribal villages of Jharkhand in 1999.

Today, Tribal School Project runs 18 schools that provide free education, from Kindergarten to High School, to around 2,900 Indian tribal children.

*Sri Sri Ravi Shankar's vision is to have "a broad-minded education, accompanied by a warm heart. Education is not just information. It is culturing of our behaviour and attitude. It is our ability to perceive things better. We need to bring in creative ideas. We should empower village youth, and bring them self-esteem."*

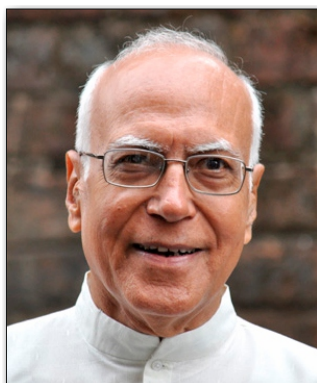

## From Director's Desk

The post Covid years were challenging, both Teachers & children had put extra efforts to cope up almost three years syllabus in 15 months.

The excellent result in class X Jharkhand board examination of 2023-24 batch (100% success and above 90% in first division) is sufficient proof of their hard work, for which they deserve appreciation.

This Year has special significance, as we will complete 25 years of our commitment to transform Tribal through education. The vision of the project when initiated in 1999 was “The Child is Focus of Development”. After 25 years we can humbly say that we are on the right track.

Our emphasis was to educate and bring the Tribal in main stream. We take pride in announcing that our teachers and students have helped us to attain this objective. Since 2012-13, 12 batches total 513 Students appeared class X Board Examination and average around 85% of them secured 1st division.

To keep pace with technological revolutions, we have introduced sessions for updating carrier options to students. We started exploring to find opportunities available and conducting personal interviews of class X and Ex-students to help in opting career based on individual's passion. Invited Guest lecturers from Railway, Army, technical training (ITIs) to address the students and explain the scope.

We also arranged training in Digital Photography and Computer Hardware repairing to interested students.

The outgoing class X students are attending special classes after school hours to i) improve communication ability ii) personality development and iii) exposure to the modern world.

The milestones of this year are

- Strengthening techniques of the activity based learning method introduced last year with a kind revisit of one of our respected volunteer from Hyderabad.
- This year also seven children, selected based on a competitive examination, received Tata Steel Foundation scholarship, of Rupees Six Thousand per year to be continued till class XII.
- In games, we have introduced Karate classes for senior students in High School.
- Both boys and girls football team of won JRD Kolhan Super League Trophy.
- Like every year, the performance in archery is commendable. In Kreedha Bharati District Tournament Sushma Mahato won 4 Gold Medals and Meghraj Soren won a Silver Medal.
- In inter camp archery tournament our team won 1 Gold and 3 Silver Medals.
- In 15<sup>th</sup> Jharkhand State Archery Championship at Hazaribagh we won two Bronze Medal.

### Independence Day and Republic Day

The students celebrated the 77th Independence Day with flag hoisting and cultural programs and distribution of sweets, in all schools.

The 75th Republic Day was celebrated in all schools, with flag hoisting, march past, cultural programs and distribution of sweets.



## Activities

### Tailoring Unit

The two sets of uniforms for about 3000 children for 17 schools under Tribal Welfare are prepared at the tailoring unit at Hendaajuri high school. About 75 women from villages and few ex-students work in the unit on rotation.



### Free Medical Camps

We are conducting fortnightly free medical camps at 12 locations, serving the villages around the school. A total number of 136 camps have been conducted during the year. Of the 4688 beneficiaries who attended the camp 690 were new patients.

### Midday Meals

We have been providing mid-day meals to 12 of our schools in Ghatsila and Ranchi. This year we have ensured that 70 g vegetables as a part of daily meal. We have been provided the funds for one year midday meal expenses under CSR by Shipping Corporation of India for which we are thankful to them.



### Parents-Teachers Meetings

Parents-Teachers Meetings are held regularly at each school to discuss various topics of academic and welfare nature. The topics covered include the academic growth of the children, regularity, assessment results, home work, preparation for Class VIII, IX and X Board exams, suggestions from parents' side for improvement, plantation of trees in the village and children's health issues.



### Class X Board Exam

The JAC conducted Class X Board exam was held in the month of April 2023. This is the 11th batch of students of Hendaajuri HS. The result was announced in June 2023. Out of 50 participant 48 obtained first division marks and 2 second division. The highest achiever was Anup Kr Mahato with 87%. This year the local administration, including MLA and Panchayat members graced the occasion and distributed the Mark Sheets.



### Organic Farming

As during every year, this year the children spent time in growing seasonal vegetables in the kitchen garden, which are added to the midday meals and also distributed to other schools. Only organic manure and natural pesticides are used. The children work in the garden during their spare time guided by a gardener.



### International Yoga Day

International Yoga Day was celebrated in all schools on 21 June 2023. In the one hour long program Children and teachers participated with lot of enthusiasm.



### Hul Diwas

Hul Diwas has been celebrated in all schools on 30 June 2023. This region falls in present-day Jharkhand, more specifically, around the Rajmahal Hills of eastern Jharkhand's Sahibganj district. Every year, the state of Jharkhand celebrates June 30 as 'Hul Diwas', marking the beginning of the rebellion.





### Word Health Day

The Word Health Day was celebrated on April 7, 2023. World Health Day is a global health awareness day celebrated every year under the sponsorship of the World Health Organization. Students took part in various activities including skits and plays to spread awareness.



### Earth Day

Earth Day is an annual celebration that honors the achievements of the environmental movement and raises awareness of the need to protect Earth's natural resources for future

generations. Students took out a procession to make the villages aware of the need to protect earth. A drawing competition was also held on the topic.



### Guruji's Birthday

Guruji's birthday was celebrated with puja, distribution of sweets, Sanskrit slokas, Gita recitation and cultural programs, on 13 May 2023.

### Drawing Competitions

The periodic group wise competitions have been held at the High School, Middle schools and primary schools. The first three drawings in each group have been awarded.





### Ambedkar Jayanti

The 132nd Birth Anniversary of Dr B R Ambedkar has been celebrated. On this auspicious day, we pay him respect and tribute for what he has contributed to Indian law and the constitution. Drawings competitions were organized on the occasion at the local Panchayat Bhawans.

### Robot Programming Classes

The Hendaljuri HS has a pair of Robots which can be programmed through a Tab. Regular training sessions are held. Every year the senior group of children pass on the training program to the next group of younger children. Recently when the local MLA visited a demo of the Robot programming project was presented to him.



### Archery Tournaments

In September 2023 nine students participated in the archery tournament organised by JRD Tata Foundation. Four boys and four girls were selected for the next level. In the second level held at Hazaribagh two girls students won Bronze medal..

In a district level Archery tournament organised by Kreedha Bharti on 7th October at Jamshedpur, Sushma Mahato of class VII,



Hendaljuri High School, won all the 4 gold medals: Under 14, Under 17, Junior and Senior categories. Meghrai Soren, our ex-student, won the silver medal in the Senior category.

The Archery team also participated in the 40th NTPC Sub Junior National selection trials at JRD Sports Complex, Jamshedpur, in December 2023. The selected members have to appear for the next level at Hazaribagh.

In the HCL Inter camp archery tournament



held at Ghatshila in January 2024, Almoni Mahato won 2 silver, Meghrai Soren Gold Medal and Shraddha Namata won the Silver medal.

### Science Projects

Class X students presented various Science projects and models prepared by them in an exhibition in the school science lab. They

had prepared models of Bank Security System, Burglar Alarm and model of Solar system.

### Plantation Drive

This year 825 saplings of fruit bearing trees have been distributed through the students of the tribal schools. There is a 12 month monitoring system in place with the help of local teachers. The children are entrusted to take care of the plants and ensure it survives. Rotary Club of Jamshedpur, also participated at Hendaljuri high school.



### Medha Yoga

A Medha Yoga session was conducted at High School in the second week of August. 250 students of Class VIII to X participated.



## Happiness Program

A session of Happiness Program was conducted for Teachers of High School and three primary schools in the second week of August 2023. 41 teachers participated.



## Conjunctivitis

At the onset of conjunctivitis in July 2023, to counter the spread of Conjunctivitis, an awareness program was organized at the school and surrounding villages.

## Swatchata Abiyan

Swatchata Abiyan programs are conducted regularly at all schools and also on special occasions. Awareness programs were also organized in the nearby villages. The children also cleaned the school and the surrounding village areas.



## Text Books Distribution

As in every year free text books for the session 2023-24 have been distributed to students of V to VIII at Kalchiti Middle and Hendaljuri High School.



## Gandhi Jayanti

Gandhi Jayanti was celebrated at all schools on 2 October 2023. The life and work of Mahatma Gandhi were explained to the students through speech and poem recitation. The day was observed as Swatchata Diwas and the students participated in the cleaning the school and surroundings.

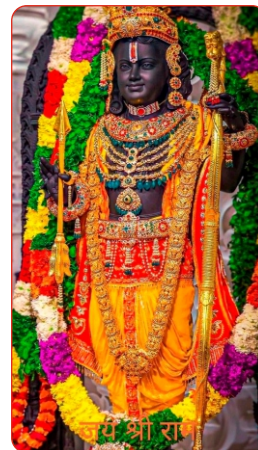


## Basic Photography Course

One of our ex-students has agreed to conduct the classes. Our well wishers provided with high quality old DSLR cameras for the students to practice.

Multimedia classes are held at all schools regularly. In the beginning of the session, NIIT Foundation along with HP Accessible Learning For All provided Multimedia equipment, suitable for online classes, at HendaJuri High School and Kalchiti school.



### Physical Training and Karate Classes

Physical Training and Karate classes have been introduced in the High School from this session



### Durga Puja Celebrations

Durga Puja and Navratri have been celebrated in all schools, before the 8 days closure. Students presented cultural programs depicting the theme of Durga Puja.



### Diwali Celebrations

Diwali has been celebrated in all schools. General Knowledge quiz, drawing and Rangoli competitions and cultural programs have been held on this occasion.

### Story Telling Competition

With a view improve the power of expression and communication skills, Story Telling Competitions were held in all schools in the month of November 2023.



### Teachers-Admin Meet

Regular meetings of all teachers with Administration are held periodically to discuss improvement in the teaching method and efforts for self-improvement.





### Sweater Distribution

Sweater, which is a part of the school uniform, has been distributed to all students in the month of October 2023, before the onset of winter.

### Teachers Training

Two Teachers Training sessions were conducted by AOL faculty from Hyderabad, Dr Sheel Parekh, for all teachers. At Hendaljuri 32 teachers and at Kalchiti 33 teachers attended the six days program.



### Vocational Training

A group of 77 Class X students visited the Indo Danish Tool Room, an ITI at Jamshedpur, to give them exposure and make them aware of the vocational training possibilities available.



### Provision of Computer Lab

Dektop PCs and printers have been provided for computer labs at three schools under CSR from PNB Housing Finance, Pehel Foundation. In all 28 PCs and 2 printers have been provided for Hendaljuri HS, Hendaljuri Primary and Kalchiti Schools.



### Solar Power Units

Solar powered backup units have been provided at Hendaljuri HS, Hendaljuri Primary and Kalchiti Middle school by PNB Housing Finance, Pehel Foundation, under CSR.

### New School Bus

A 36-seater school bus has been provided for Hendaljuri High school by PNB Housing Finance, Pehel Foundation, under CSR.



### Saraswati Puja

Saraswari Puja, a very important festival in this area, has been celebrated on 14 February 2024 in all schools. Children attended the school in colorful costumes, participated in the Puja and enjoyed the special midday meal.

### Scholarship

For the second year in a row, seven Class VII students from Hendaljuri High School have been selected for scholarship under JRD Jyoti Fellowship. They will receive an annual scholarship of Rs. 6,000 to Rs.18,000/- till they complete Class XII



### Football Tournaments

The boys and girls football team of Hendaljuri High School participated in tournament organised by JRD Tata Foundation at Ulda on 27 January 2024. Sixteen girls and 25 boys participated in the event. The girls team was declared Runners Up.

In another tournament organised by JRD Tata Kohan Super League on 30 January 2024, a 41 member team participated. The boys team was declared winners and the girls Runner Up in their group. On 18 February 2024, a 39 member team participated in the tournament organised by JRD Tata Kolhan Super League.

At the football tournament organised by JRD Foundation at Tin Plate, on 18 March 2024, the SSVM Hendaljuri team won the second Runners Up trophy. Nineteen teams participated in the event.

Young India Foundation, Jamshedpur, organised a Free Eye Check Up and Consultation camp at HendaJuri High School conducted by doctors from ASG Eye Hospitals, on 12 March 2024. About 200 students and villagers have undergone the check up.



### Program on Hygiene

Young India Foundation, Jamshedpur, held an awareness program for girl students of Class V to X on Menstrual Hygiene guidelines. Main motive is to educate girls and prevent absence from the schools, work places, daily activities, manage menstrual symptoms, precautions, prevent ill effects on humans as well the environment.



### Meeting with Teachers

A meeting of the Administration with teachers from all the schools was held in the third week of January 2024. The self-improvement of teachers and teaching methods were discussed. The use of school library was also discussed. The teachers presented their ideas on improved teaching methods, which can be adopted by their colleagues.

### New Admissions

The new admissions for Shishu class at primary schools and for class V and VI at HendaJuri High School were conducted in the 1st week of March 2024 for the next session. About 250 new admissions are registered for Class Shishu and about 108 students have been added to HendaJuri High School roll.







### International Women's Day

The International Women's Day has been celebrated at school. Seven teachers participated in a session organised at Jamshedpur by Young India Foundation. The session encouraged women to work for the progress of all women in their field.

### World Water Day

The International Water Day was organized in all schools. The importance of saving water and avoid wastage were discussed. Nukkad Natak on preservation of water was presented.



### Children Safety Awareness

An awareness program on Child protection/welfare was conducted at Hendaajuri High School by volunteers from Young India Foundation. The comprehensive presentation discussed the precautions to be taken in preventing sexual, emotional, and physical abuse of children aged 3 to 11 years.

### Blanket Distribution

This year also blankets were distributed to poor senior citizens in the villages. In all 250 blankets were distributed.





## Infrastructure under CSR

The infrastructure of all the 11 schools under Ghatsila block got major repairs/modification done, supported by a donor from Mumbai. The project was of approx. Rs. 50 lakhs. All the schools got a face lift and drinking water facilities for children.
